Her acts of kindness and compassion coupled with the contents of her six diaries have been the foundation for Rachel's Challenge, one of the most life-changing school programs in America. Powerful video/audio footage of Rachel's life and the Columbine tragedy holds students spellbound during a one hour school presentation that motivates them to positive change in the way they treat others. That evening the Rachel's Challenge presenter conducts a session with parents and community leaders. This session is similar to the assembly program and ends with a specific challenge to parents and community leaders, showing them how they can reinforce the decisions their youth are making.
